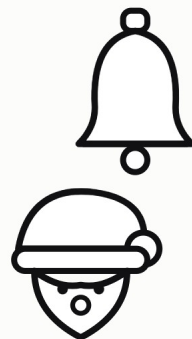
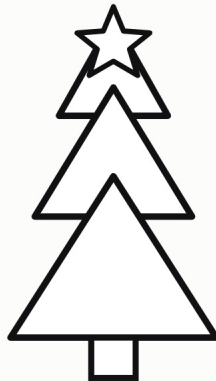
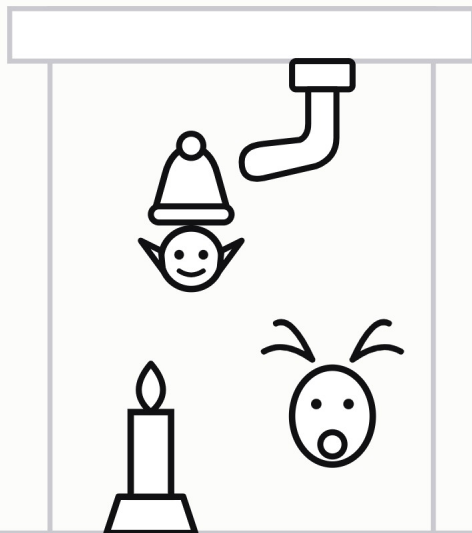

-  Colour the **short-e** words (like b e ll) **YELLOW**
-  Colour the **ee** words (like tr ee) **GREEN**
