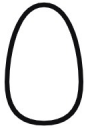




Egg Hunt Sounds

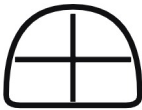
Say each picture. Write the first letter you hear on the line.

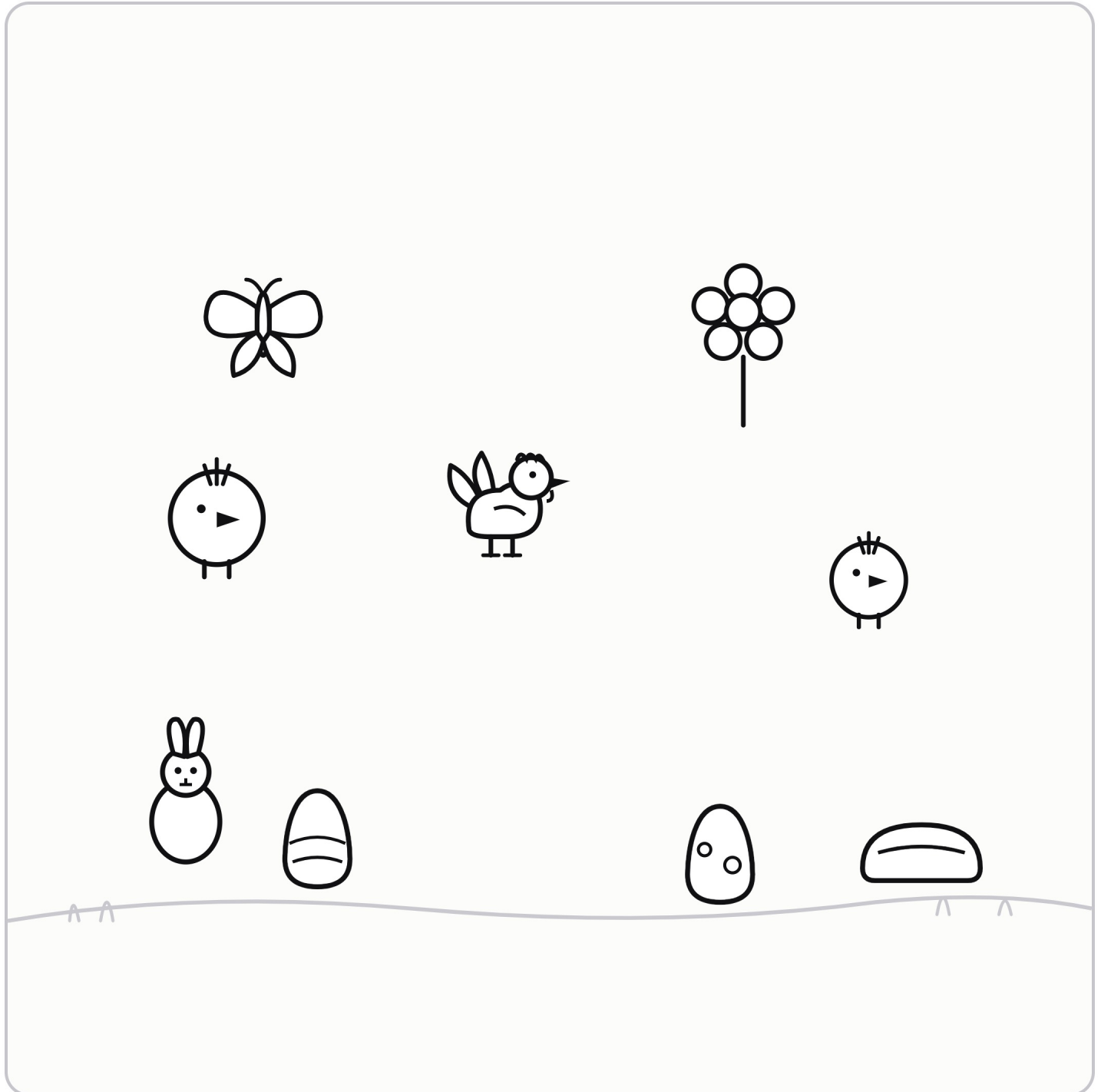

Every word here is decodable: short vowels, the **ch** and **ck** in chick, and **gr/ss** in grass. Blend it slowly — ch-i-ck, g-r-a-ss — then say it fast.

4 Hunt & colour the egg garden!

-  Colour everything that starts with /ch/ **ORANGE**
-  Colour the **short-e** words (like h e n) **GREEN**
-  Colour the **short-u** words (like b u n) **BLUE**



Grown-up: the rabbit, the flower & the butterfly are tricks — they don't match a colour rule. Leave them white!
