

Reading Bingo

Cross off one square a day. Aim for a row in a week, the full card in a month.

Read a page to a parent	Find 5 things starting with /s/	Write your name 3 times	Listen to a story for 10 minutes	Read in your pajamas
Read a sentence to a sibling	Find a word that rhymes with cat	Copy a word from a book	Retell a story you heard	Read in a fort
Clap the syllables in your name	Read in a silly voice	FREE SPACE	Read to a stuffed animal	Find 3 letters on a sign
Say all the sounds in "fish"	Predict what happens next in a book	Write a tiny sentence	Read outside	Pick a brand new book
Build a sound out of LEGO	Draw and label something	Name 3 characters from a book	Teach someone a sound	Read 2 pages by yourself

HOW TO USE

- Pick one square each day. Cross it off when done.
- Too hard? Skip it and pick another. The card is a guide, not a contract.
- A small reward at the end of a row is optional but works well for many kids.
- Stick this on the fridge so it lives somewhere visible.
